Our Classrooms

Each classroom utilizes the following elements...

- **Bible Lesson** - We use the Orange curriculum which is age appropriate, engaging and is intended to anchor children's faith to what Jesus said and did.
- **Music** - The music is designed to exalt the person and work of God through Scripture-saturated lyrics, age-appropriate instrumentation, and engaging hand motions.
- **Crafts** - These creative activities capture children's attention and reinforce the Bible lesson.
- **Snack** - A small snack is offered to the children, If you would not like your child to have a snack, simply inform the Sunday School teacher.

Behaviour Expectations

To make the classroom a beneficial learning environment for all children, Kingdom Kids Ministry and our volunteer Sunday school teachers and helpers expect certain behaviour from children.

The behaviour expectations for Sunday School Children are:

- Be ready to have fun and learn about God
- Participate in classroom activities
- Follow the teacher's instructions
- Show respect to others in the classroom
- Keep hands and feet to self
- Speak in turn and listen when others speak
- Take care of the classroom (use materials wisely and help cleanup)



Corrective Action Plan

If a child does not meet the behaviour expectations, the teacher will inform the child that his/her behaviour does not meet expectations and will inform them of the expected behaviour.

The child will be given an opportunity to correct their behaviour using a 1, 2, 3 method: 1 = grace, 2 = a warning, and 3 = student is removed from the activity and the classroom and is expected to return and sit with their parents. Any disruptive behaviour will be reported to and discussed with parents/guardians.

COLLECTING YOUR CHILDREN AFTER THE SERVICE (PRESCHOOL/KINDERGARTEN)

At the end of the service, it is the responsibility of a child's parent(s)/ guardian(s) to collect their child/children from the Kingdom Kids groups in the specific classrooms. Every Sunday the adult teaching and ministry time will be about 45 minutes long. Kingdom Kids will also run during this same 45-minute period, meaning that when the adults' time ends, the kids' time ends as well. We ask that parents be courteous to the needs of the kids' teams by picking their children up in a timely fashion, as the role of a Kingdom Kids volunteer should not extend beyond the scheduled learning time. There needs to be a clear hand-off between the kingdom kid's team and the child's parents, so that parents know that they have taken over responsibility for their child.
